

# Barringer To Succeed Newpher As Head Of Community College

T. Bayard Williams, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Community Colleges in Baltimore County, has announced the appointment of Dr. Robert A. Barringer as President of the Catonsville Community College, effective August 1, 1968.

Dr. Barringer, President of the College of The Albermarle, Elizabeth City, North Carolina, succeeds Dr. James A. Newpher who will retire as President of the Catonsville Community College June 30, 1968.

A graduate of Wake Forest University in 1954, Dr. Barringer earned his Doctor's degree in education in 1964 at the University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida and has done additional graduate work at the Teachers' College, Columbia University in New York.

For three years, from 1958 until 1961, Dr. Barringer was a senior high school instructor of history and in 1961 became an instructor at the Orlando Junior College. In 1963 he was a Supervisor of Interns at the University of Florida and in 1964 was appointed Dean of Instruction at the College of The Albermarle where he became president in 1966.

From 1954 to 1958 Dr. Barringer served with the United States Marine Corps as a Platoon Commander. In addition to his activity in many professional organizations, he has served on the Advisory Committee for Mental Health Center, The Tidewater Council for Boy Scouts of America and the Board of Directors of Economic Council O.E.O. and is a member of Rotary.
